The application essay topic is: “How have applied theories and methods influenced your research or career goals, and how might participation in the SfAA help you to achieve these goals?” Whether you are experienced in applied methodologies or not, we encourage you to write this essay to explore the idea of how applied methods and your active membership in SfAA could inspire (or has already inspired or transformed) your research or career as a social scientist.

All materials must be received on or before **January 14**. Once received, applications will be checked for completeness and then organized by the Student Committee Awards Officer. *The winner will be announced in February.
